#### **KSA Endeavors to Reduce Salt Consumption**

The first in the Arab world and regionally to enact legislations and procedures to curb excessive salt consumption

#### Measures implemented to curb salt consumption:

- Implementing a mandatory limit for salt content in all types of bread not exceeding 1 gm/ 100 gm.
- Implementing a mandatory limit for salt content in in ayran (yogurt drink) not exceeding 1 gm/ 100 ml.
- Establishing an optional mechanism to clarify the nutritional content, through a visual signal.
- Mandating the disclosure of nutritional data for products, including salt content.
- Establishing guideline limits for salt content in 24 food categories

- Publishing categorized lists of carcinogenic substances, compounds, and chemical mixtures.
